**All grave markers and monuments are lot owners' responsibility to be set in a wet mixture of crushed rock, sand and Portland cement fifteen inches (15") deep and formed with a four inch (4") border on all four sides. Maximum width for the foundation pad is 36" per space in all sections of the cemetery. Maximum width for the monument is 28" per space in all sections of the cemetery. Granite pads may be used. Above ground foot markers will not be allowed. Ground level markers are allowed. Granite resting benches to be installed in line with monuments. Nothing is to be over burial spaces. All vases and monuments are lot owners' responsibility. Cemetery Board must approve all markers.**
